- 3. Each submission must be entirely your own work and once submitted, Benedictine College will have free rights to use video.
- 4. All individuals who appear in your video must agree to being featured.
- 5. Submissions must conform to Benedictine College's mission and values.

  Submissions must be appropriate for display and publication. Submissions must not contain defamatory statements; invade privacy or other rights of any person or entity; violate applicable laws, including copyright laws, or reasonable standards of decency.
- 6. Any use of Benedictine logos must conform to Benedictine College logo standards.
- 7. Submissions must be submitted online and run between 30 seconds–2 minutes. Submissions not adhering to these technical requirements will not be considered.
- 8. Submissions will be judged on originality, creativity, production values, and positive portrayal of gratitude towards generosity of donors. The video with the most student, staff and faculty votes will determine the winner.
- 9. First prize will be awarded \$250.
- 10. Entry deadline is April 1, 2015 at midnight. Voting will begin April 6, 2015 at 8:00 a.m. and will cease at April 9 at noon. Winner will be announced April 9 during the Benefactor Panel.

Logo Usage Guide 2014-2015

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#### **Signature Components and Standards**



#### **Overview**

Uniform use of the Benedictine College signature builds awareness of the college in the Catholic and academic communities and beyond. As such, the Benedictine College signature should be used in accordance with the guidelines in this approved artwork guide.

### Components of the Benedictine College Signature

- 1. Benedictine College Mark. A graphic representation of the letter B with a red Benedictine cross in the center. The cross is the Christian symbol of salvation. The characteristic Benedictine shape reminds us of the work of evangelizing and civilizing England and Europe, and by extension Atchison, carried out by Benedictine monks and nuns.
- 2. Logotype. "Benedictine College" set in modified versions of Berthold City Bold and Medium typefaces respectively.

A subordinate area may be used in the individualized signatures for each major unit: campus, college/school, administrative unit, corporate affiliate, academic department, etc. (see Primary & Subordinate Areas, Section XXXX).

#### **Please Note:**

The Berthold City font was customized for the logo and logotype, so **NO PART OF THE BENEDICTINE COLLEGE SIGNATURE SHOULD BE RESET.** The Benedictine College signature is configured both horizontally and vertically. The vertical (as shown above) configuration is preferred. The horizontal configuration should be used only when space is limited or when the printed piece has a vertical orientation (see Vertical Configuration, Section XXX).

#### **Vertical Configuration**

The preferred use of the Benedictine College signature is in its vertical configuration. The components of the signature should not be separated. Because the font was customized for the logotype, neither should be reset.

#### **Clear Space**

Clear space requirements must be observed, except in special, pre-approved circumstances.



#### **Minimum Size**

The height of the vertical Benedictine College signature should not be less than ¾ inch in print, shown here in actual size.



#### **Horizontal Configuration**

While the vertical signature is preferred, the horizontal version may be used when space is limited or when the printed piece has a horizontal orientation. The components of the signature should not be separated. Because the font was customized for the logotype, it should not be reset. In the horizontal configuration, the logotype and subordinate area must be to the right of the "B" mark. Color and clear space requirements are the same as for the vertical configuration.



#### **Clear Space**

Clear space requirements must be observed, except in special, pre-approved circumstances.



#### **Minimum Size**

The height of the Horizontal Benedictine College signature should not be less than ½ inch in print,



#### **Color Standards**

The colors used in Benedictine College's signature help make it a distinguishable element of Benedictine College's Brand. It is important to be consistent in the use of color.

#### **Three-Color Signature**

The three-color signature is always preferred. It should be used on a white or light background. When the three-color signature is used on a dark background, the logotype should be reversed (white). Do not use the signature on a background that provides insufficient contrast. When the signature is used on a photographic background, drop shadows or a white glow may be used to enhance legibility. Consider printing the signature on a white bar if legibility would be compromised by the background image.

#### **One-Color Signature**

If used in one color, the signature should be printed in Benedictine Black or Benedictine Red (PMS 201).





#### **Reversed Three-Color and One-Color Signature**

When using a dark or solid-color background, the signature color(s) should be reversed (white).

#### **Alterations**

The horizontal and vertical configurations and color standards for the Benedictine College signature are intended to meet most design needs. Exceptions to the guidelines in this document may be made only with prior approval.



DO NOT REPOSITION, RESIZE OR SEPARATE COMPONENTS



DO NOT CREATE A DECORATIVE PATTERN WITH ANY PART OF THE SIGNATURE



DO NOT OVERLAP OTHER LOGOS OR MARKS


#### The Benedictine College "B" Mark

The Benedictine College "B" mark alone, as the dominant part of the signature, has a great deal of visible presence on apparel and promotional items. The "B" mark is a federally registered trademark and the circle R must always accompany the mark when used by itself.




#### **Clear Space**

Clear space requirements must be observed, except in special, pre-approved circumstances.



#### **Color Standards**

The "B" mark should appear in the standard three color version as either spot colors Benedictine Black (PMS Black) Benedictine Red (PMS 201) and Benedictine Gray (PMS Cool Gray 8) or in the Pantone® Matching System (PMS) standardized process color (CMYK) builds of these colors. Single spot color versions are permissible in White (reversed




#### "Rocky the Raven"

Rocky the Raven is an iconic presence on the Benedictine College campus and on apparel and other promotional items. It often represents Benedictine College in place of or in addition to the Benedictine College logo and signature. As such, a set of guidelines has been developed for using Rocky in print and on promotional items.


#### **Acceptable Variations**

Rocky the Raven can face either right or left.




#### **Clear Space**

Clear space requirements must be observed, except in special, pre-approved circumstances.



#### **Grayscale Rocky the Raven**

The grayscale Rocky the Raven is acceptable ONLY for high-quality print reproduction.




#### **Minimum Size**

The height of Rocky the Raven should not be less than 1/2 inch in print, shown here in actual size.



#### **Color Standards**

Rocky the Raven should appear in the standard three color version as either spot colors Benedictine Black (PMS Black) Benedictine Red (PMS 201) and Benedictine Gray (PMS Cool Gray 8) or in the Pantone® Matching System (PMS) standardized process color (CMYK) builds of these colors. Single spot color versions are permissible in White (reversed out of a dark background - preferably Benedictine Black or Benedictine Red), Benedictine Black and Benedictine Red.

Color is possibly the most significant identifier that the college uses. Red and black have long been the identifying colors for Benedictine College. With the new Benedictine College signature, colors have been updated to provide a fresh, modern feel while the design retains the history and prestige of the college. The addition of the cool gray color was introduced to enhance the classic design.

#### **Primary Palette**

The official Benedictine College red is referred to as Benedictine Red PANTONE (PMS) 201. The gray used in the logotype is PANTONE (PMS) Cool Gray 8. You may substitute a 40% black screen for PMS Cool Gray 8. Whenever possible, print Benedictine Red (PMS 201) as a spot or fifth color to ensure color accuracy.
