The University requires visitors to campus and to University-sponsored events and gatherings to be fully vaccinated and to comply with mask requirements.

Before arriving on campus, visitors must complete a <u>PennOpen Campus</u> prescreening on the day they visit. They must present their Green Pass on request.

The University requests that visitors not come physically to campus if they feel ill, have been exposed to a case of COVID-19, or if they are not fully vaccinated.

Visitors should be reminded that they impact 37,000 Penn students, faculty, staff, and postdocs, as well as the surrounding West Philadelphia community.

Public health guidance continues to evolve.
