Anthony Magaraci '06

Anthony Magaraci is an entrepreneur, thought leader, philanthropist and musician who currently serves as the founder and CEO of three companies: Trinity Packaging Supply, SupplyStream™ and Palmpalm™.

At age 27, Anthony founded Trinity Packaging Supply from his home office in 2010 with one goal: to disrupt the packaging industry. Since then, Trinity has experienced sustained hyper-growth, doubling revenue every two years to become a \$100 million company. Trinity has made the Inc. 5000 Fastest-Growing Companies in America list seven times in a row, the Inc. Best Places to Work list three times, the inaugural Inc. Power Partner 2022 and was ranked 89th on America's Most Innovative Companies 2023 list by *Fortune Magazine*.

Anthony is changing the packaging industry through his first-of-its-kind e-commerce platform, SupplyStream™. This proprietary software aggregates hundreds of supplier catalogs into one e-commerce catalog and automatically finds the best prices and quickest lead times based on shipping zip codes. Trinity, powered by SupplyStream™, is the wholesale industry's equivalent to Uber competing in the transportation industry.

As a philanthropist, Anthony is passionate about giving back to the community. In 2022 alone, he donated over \$2 million to charitable causes, including the American Heart Association, Hiring Our Heroes, the NAACP Youth Council and the Let It Be Foundation.

Anthony is a member of Young Presidents' Organization (YPO), an exclusive networking group with over 33,000 members spanning 130 countries. When the pandemic hit in 2020, Anthony helped form the YPO Manufacturing Coalition to Fight COVID-19, which worked with companies domestically as well as India and China to ensure an available supply of PPE at a time when no one could procure any.

In addition to Trinity's various accolades, Anthony holds many distinguished awards. He was named South Jersey Entrepreneur of the Year, one of the Greater Irvine Chamber of Commerce's 40 Under 40 winners and was a finalist for the *Orange County Business Journal's* Excellence in Entrepreneurship Award.

Anthony was one of the first eight graduates of Rowan University's Entrepreneurship Program, where he received a bachelor of science degree in Business Administration: Entrepreneurship. Not only did Rowan's Entrepreneurship Program prove Anthony's long-held belief that entrepreneurship is teachable, but it also provided him with a network of experienced faculty and the mentality necessary to be a successful entrepreneur. Today, Anthony serves on Rowan's Entrepreneurship Advisory Council, mentoring the next generation of entrepreneurs. He was part of the William G. Rohrer College of Business's first-ever speaker series and his entrepreneurial success is featured in the textbook *Entrepreneurship: The Practice and Mindset* by Heidi Neck.

He resides in Newport Beach, California with his wife and three children. In his spare time, Anthony enjoys music, plays the guitar and holds a blue belt in Jiu Jitsu.
