Program Policies

CHILDREN: Families are welcome and encouraged to attend with the following restrictions: all children 18 and under must be accompanied by a parent, grandparent, legal guardian or adult with proper authorization; all children under the age of 14 must have a parent participating in the same community throughout the duration of the program; we cannot accommodate any children under the age of 12 on the program.

COVID, HEALTH, MEDICAL: Yale Alumni Service Corps (“YASC”), as part of the Yale Alumni Association (“YAA”), will follow the requirements of Yale University and of Brazil, as regards to health policy related to COVID, vaccinations, and other medical issues. Participants will abide by these requirements and the Terms and Conditions for this program.

YASC CODE OF CONDUCT: Every participant on this program will be required to read, acknowledge, and sign the YASC Volunteer Code of Conduct. This important document communicates the values of Yale and YASC with respect to service trips, delineates the expectations for volunteers, and the commitment by service trip volunteers to adhere to all policies and procedures.
